Dear Parents/Carers,

Great news, I am writing to confirm that we will be taking the Year 6 children on a residential visit to White Hall Centre, Long Hill, Buxton. The children will stay from 18th to 20th July 2018. White Hall is an activity centre run by Derbyshire County Council providing a range of activities, for all needs, specifically designed to include all children in a secure and safe environment. The activities range from problem solving, team building and adventurous tasks which challenge the children intellectually as well as physically. They are exciting, stimulating and highly enjoyable. The range of activities devised range from Orienteering, Avoiding Sharks to Canoeing, Rock Scrambling and evening activities such as Star Ambush and many more. The children also have the chance to undertake tasks, which will allow them to become independent but above all it is a chance for the children to enjoy their final days of school with their friends before moving onto their new school next year.

A timetable and kit list for the visit will be sent at a later date. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact me.

The cost of the visit will be £170.00, which we would be grateful if you could pay via **PARENT PAY**. No child will be placed at a disadvantage because of parents' unwillingness or inability to pay.

Please would you be so kind as to return the slip attached to school whether your child would like to be included in plans for the visit or not. We are asking for a **non-returnable deposit of £40.00** to be paid to the school by Friday 26th January 2018 to secure a place on the trip. To conform with White Hall's conditions we would appreciate payment of a further £65.00 by Friday 23rd March 2018. The final balance of £65.00 is payable by Friday 15th June 2018. Please note that cancellation of a place after the 23rd March 2018 will incur cancellation charges, this will depend on the notice given and can be discussed at that time.

We are still able to accept cash or cheque payments if you prefer, all cheques should be made payable to Swanwick Primary School. Please send all payments in a sealed envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and addressed for the attention of Mrs Strong. The children will receive a "paying in card" as receipt for the deposit, and as a record of further payments towards the final cost. You will also be able to view your balance in **Parent Pay**.
