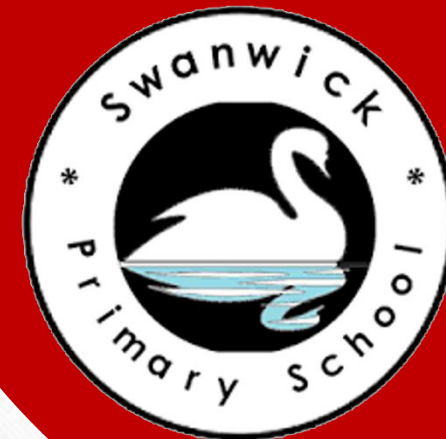

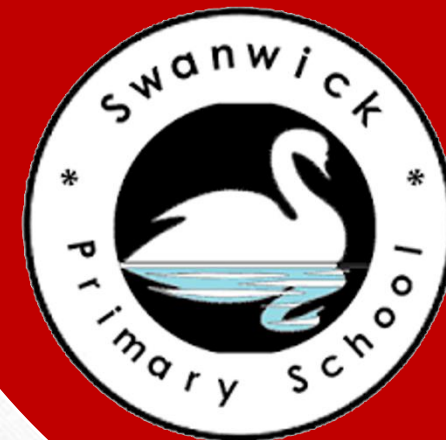

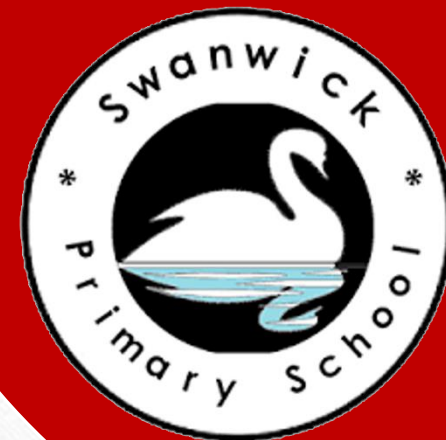
- Trousers or shorts- plain grey or black

Children should not wear fake tan or adhesive tattoos.

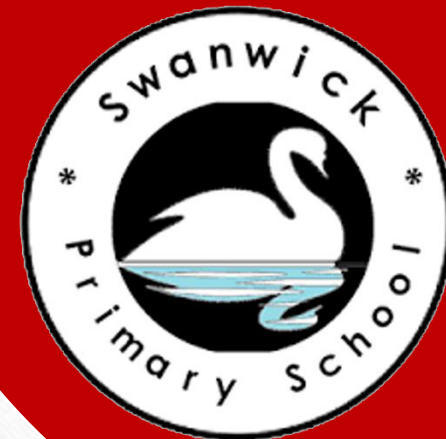
Hair ties must be sensible and kept to a minimum.

- All jewellery (exception of stud earrings) must be removed before PE and Swimming

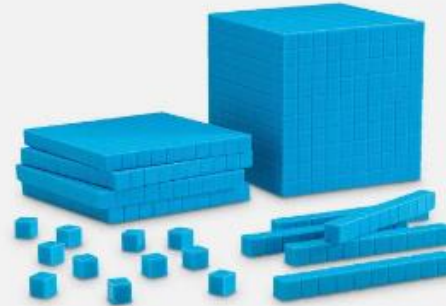
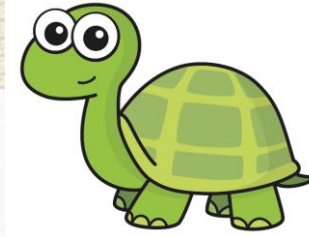


Reading expectations

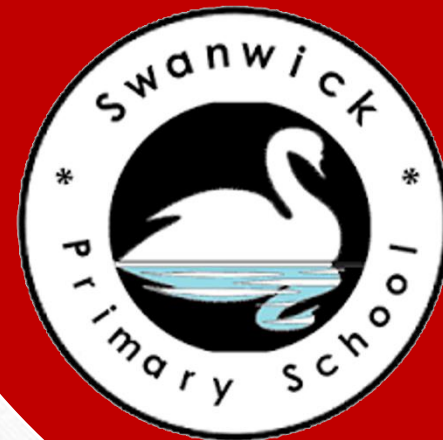
