Please call the school number as early as possible to make the school aware. You may need to leave a message on our answer machine, but these are checked as soon as our office staff arrive in school and they will then alert the class teacher. Please state your child's name, their class teacher, their class name, the reason for illness and your full name and relationship with the child. It is unlikely a member of staff will call you back unless they need further information.

Please state the same details as above. In addition, state the time of the appointment and who will be collecting your child (if this is not before school), the time you intend to bring your child back and if they still require a school lunch. If you are collecting your child during the school day, use the South Street Gate buzzer to talk to the office staff. They will usually collect your child and bring them to the gate or may ask you to enter the site to sign your child out.

Lost Clothing

In the first instance, your child's class teachers will be available at the start and the end of the school day. If the item cannot be found, we have a Lost property station outside the PPOD for short term lost items. If you are looking for something that went missing a week or more ago, there is a long term lost property area in our Treetop Room. This is open to parents after school on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 3-3:30pm.
