

Classroom Environment- Changes ahead!

We have begun to prepare our school for September 23-24. We are always looking at ways we can improve children's learning experiences and we have one key change coming in September 2023- All our classrooms will be changing towards a more neutral colour scheme.

A large body of research suggests that too much colour can provide a sensory overload for our children, creating an environment where they are less likely to be highly involved and more likely to be distracted. An overstimulating brightly coloured classroom can lead to unsettled children.

Our key aims are;

- To support children with sensory or SEN needs
- To provide a calm canvas for work to be the focus
- To provide consistency across the school

We want our children's work to be the focus and not the backgrounds. We want the children to use our working walls to support their learning and not just see them as wallpaper.
