Another reminder that once the gate is closed at 8.55am each morning, then the gate should remain closed in order to safeguard your children.

We ask that unless you have an appointment, you don't enter the site with your child if you are late. Office staff will support children in Reception to their classes.

We really don't like to moan, but we are becoming increasingly worried about the driving and parking around the site again.

We know that school being between two cul-desacs is not ideal, but this is something we have to live with. Therefore, it is everyone's responsibility to make sure that they park and drive safely to prevent an accident – or even worse – a fatality.

These are the ways you can help to improve this:

- Park further away from school and walk if you can
- Keep all yellow lines clear at all times
- Don't use the school driveways to turn your car around in
- Keep pavements clear of parked cars
- Please drive slowly around the school area
- Arrive in plenty of time some parents appear to be purposefully arriving late in order to avoid traffic and have a parking space/turn around in the school drive.
 This has a real knock-on effect to your child having a positive start to the day
- Report cars which are parked/driving dangerously or illegally to the police
