## Lost Property

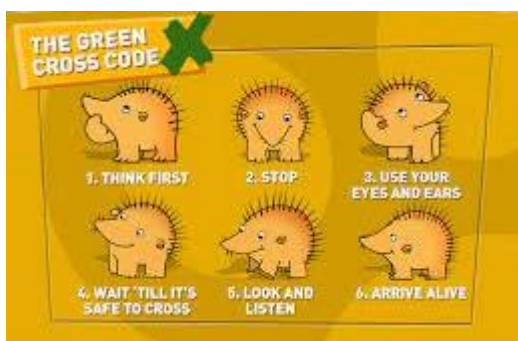

## Heatwave Guidance

We are expecting very high temperatures on Monday and Tuesday of next week. We are following guidance on how to keep the children safe in a heatwave. This includes use of shaded areas only- at lunch and break times, encouraging children to take regular drinks from our water coolers and keeping blinds down and ventilation maximised. We will also be avoiding any outdoor exercising over these two days. **We have taken the decision to ask you to send your child into school wearing lighter clothing, if you wish.** This might be their school PE kit, or a cooler plain t-shirt and shorts. As the temperatures rise, please remember your children **must bring a sun hat** to school and **must bring a water bottle**. We also ask that children come to school with sun cream applied.
